- > 1,800 teachers




"Lernstatt' Guiding Principles



- A low-maintenance infrastructure in all schools that promotes learning
 - individual access for all approx. 19,000 users
 - web-based and everywhere available
 - mobile and time-independent use
 - provision of services
 - presentation technique in classrooms
 - central IT-Administration
 - uniform infrastructure

72.500 inhabitants

• 45 schools of regional importance

Initial situation:

The school closures caused by the pandemic and the subsequent limited opening of school operations had a huge impact on pupils.


Pupils had to face restrictions in everyday life as well as insecurity and a situation of perceivable danger.



Betreutes

Initial situation:

- reports from youth social work
- reports from school
- lack of media literacy
- lack of technical requirements





"How strongly origin or socio-economic background and educational success are linked" has recently become more than clear.

"Homeschooling has widened the education gap even further."



Planning:

In consultation with the State Education Authority for City and County Landshut and the Government of Lower Bavaria, the primary school St. Nikola was selected as model school for the project because of their biggest need of support.

Problem analysis with the pilot primary school "Grundschule St. Nikola":

Experiences during the "homeschooling" phase during lockdown (March - June)

- approx. 80 90 % of the pupils tried to complete the tasks by homeschooling
- some families could not support their children
- some families were not be able to be contected

Problem analysis with the pilot primary school "Grundschule St. Nikola":

Experiences in the face-to-face teaching after lockdown

- low learning outcomes
- partially regression in many areas of knowledge
- Differences between the level of knowledge
- educational levels within a class group varied widely
- challenges for teachers in the classroom (wodurch)

different educational levels of individual pupils (new heterogeneous group)

Project objectives:

The following objectives were formulated for the target group of our project:

- Children from socially disadvantaged families are supported.
- Children are enabled to regain stability and structure in everyday life.
- Learning gaps are avoided.
- Already acquired knowledge is maintained and improved.
- Children's social and personal skills are promoted systematically and sustainably.
- Children's pressure due to difficult family situations is reduced.
- The professional situation of parents is improved.
- Difficult situations for teachers are mitigated.

(Partial) compensation of weaknesses of home schooling in a difficult social environment

EXTRACURRICULAR OFFER at SCHOOL

Timeline:

- usual daily structure
- paying attention to concentration and recovery phases
- time scope similar to school times: in the mornings parallel to the school day

Example:

08:00 - 08:30 Welcome / morning circle / discussion of the day

08:30 - 09:45 Learning support

09:45 - 10:05 Break

10:05 - 11:00 Learning support (if necessary)

11:00 - 12:00 Educational leisure time (e.g. reading mentoring, learning games)


12:00 - 12:30 Closing / reflection / daily evaluation

Prerequisites for the selection of pupils for "Assisted Learning":

The target group had to prove:

- they have no right to emergency care
- they are eligibal for benefits from the "education and participation package" (securing financing)

The school took care to ensure that the pupils had the following characteristics:

- critical social environment
- no support at home and no daily rhythm conducive to learning
- not being able to successfully complete learning at home
- special educational needs or learning difficulties
- little knowledge of the German language and/or with parents without sufficient knowledge of German







To evaluate the measures of the project, a questionnaire was used. Its results visualise the benefits achieved by the target groups.









Evaluation:

Children's voices:

- It's better for me now because I can learn better.
- Without supervision it was strange for me, because sometimes I did not understand anything at home.
- It was hard to do the exercises at home because it was hard to concentrate and if I didn't understand something, my parents couldn't help because they hadn't learned it.
- Without the assisted learning it was strange at home because I was so bored.

Parents' voices:

- We were able to work longer.
- My child has improved and now has something to do and that is better.

Teaching staff's voices:


- The children are more motivated.
- They understand their homework better and are less frustrated.
- It was very helpful for the children and they were enthusiastic.
- The pupils seemed more balanced and stable.




The project showed benefits for several target groups:

Potential for transfer:

- Project was classified under the priority area of learning support (destinction from school)
- Extracurricular care services
- Model schools are certainly not the norm, with a migration share of approx. 90%, but larger towns and cities show similar constellations
- Transferability to secondary schools is easily possible


