

Data that is indispensable for the economic continuity and growth of a company. It has been structured, which is why we also speak of "clean data".





The acronym stands for "redundant, obsolete and trivial", i.e. for data that exists several times, is not needed for other reasons and is therefore worthless.



Dark data is unclassified, i.e. unused data whose content and use is unknown. This group is growing faster and faster.

A truly expensive "hobby"

In a smaller company that has accumulated about 250 terabytes of data, the estimated total cost of annual data storage is **1.25 Million US-Dollars.**



With unpredictable legal risks

The assumed 250 terabytes corresponds to roughly 580 million files. The content of more than half, i.e. just over 300 million files, is completely unknown. Many of these files contain personal information, i.e. information relevant to the GDPR.






