
Explanation of the expected outcomes and benefits for participating municipalities

Goals and objectives define desired outcomes and guide decision-making.




Action Plans

foundation of a successful strategic plan. A clear and concise vision and mission statement sets the tone for the entire plan and provides direction for decision-making.




SWOT Analysis


Goals and Objectives

Action Plan




Process of Developing Strategic Plans Step-bystep explanation of the strategic planning process:


Implementing Your Strategies




