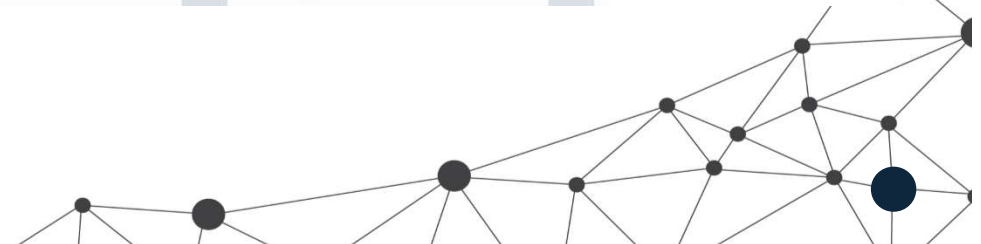
Our approach:

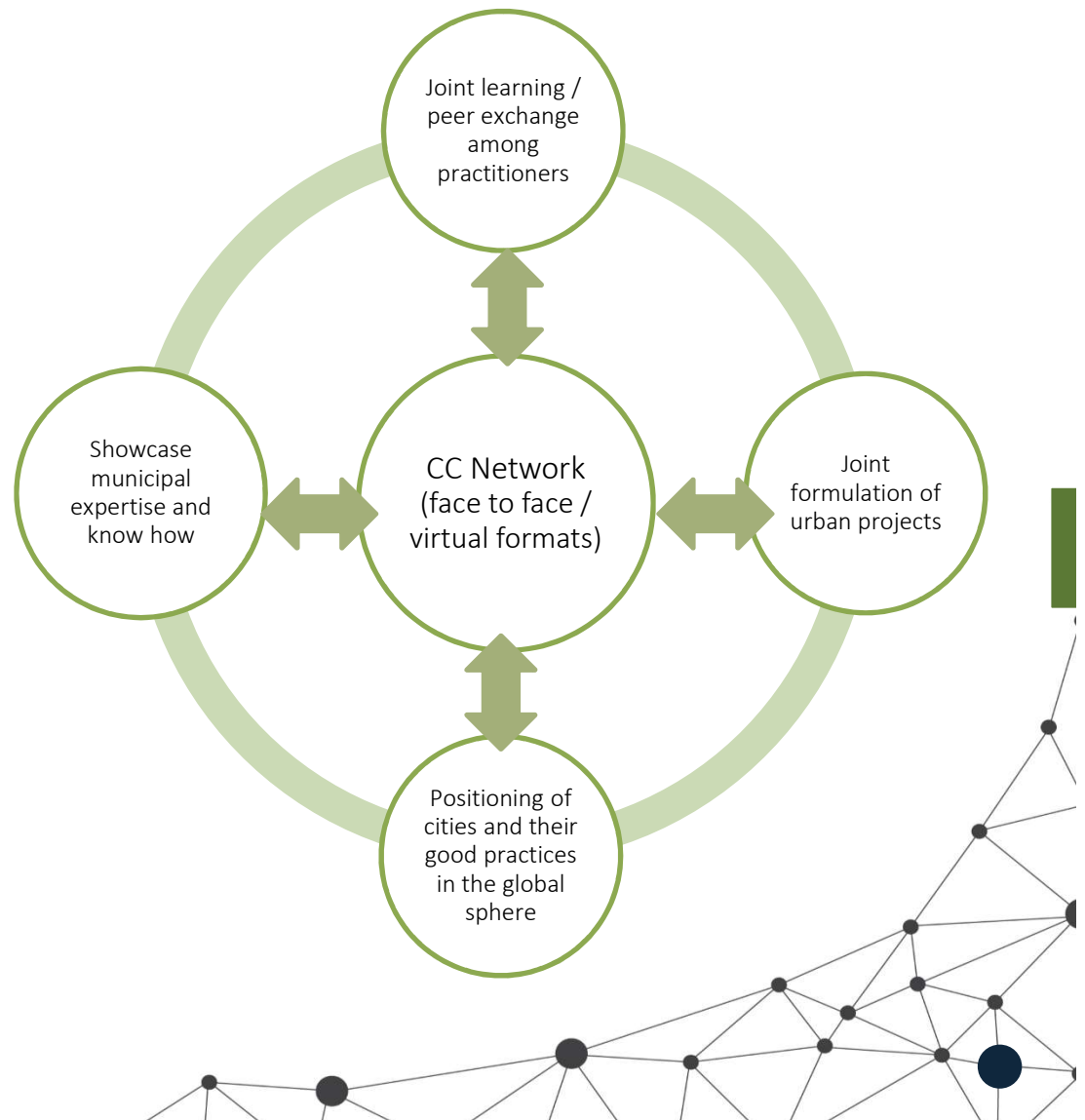
