

Key issues


What transformation processes are taking place in my municipality? In which transformation fields is my municipality / region well positioned and where is it less so?

Where is there a critical mass of players and where is there not?











DISTRIBUTION OF COMPETENCES WITHIN A REGION USING THE EXAMPLE OF LOWER SAXONY


Intensity of R&D activities








UNDERSTANDING REGIONAL TRANS-FORMATION PROCESSES IN ORDER TO SHAPE THEM




THE CITY OF MANNHEIM AS DRIVER FOR REGIONAL TRANSFORMATION





- ... an attractive place to do business, work and live





SUMMARY

Municipalities / regions are suitable for taking on a new role as drivers of regional transformation processes, **but**

- Strong regional roots and close co-operation with regional intermediaries are an important prerequisite for taking on such a role.
- Regional transformation processes must first be understood in order to be able to coordinate them.
- Sufficient human resources, expertise and sustainable financing of cluster initiatives is a fundamental prerequisite.
